OUR PURPOSE:

Emergency Services provided: Case Management, Five Food Pantries, Financial Assistance, Disaster Preparation and Recovery, Agape Food Bank.

Self-Sufficiency Services: Visitation House for pregnant homeless women, Shepherd's House for homeless women with children, My Sister's House a safe place for women and children of domestic violence, Pathways to Care for homeless men and women who need a place to recover following hospitalization and Pathways to Independence for residence to transition from PTC to living and working independently.

Immigration Services assists our nation's newest residents settle in their new country.

Refugee Services provides support for individuals and families fleeing persecution from their country of origin.

The Counseling Center provides mental health counseling for individuals, couples and families, including post traumatic stress, premarital and post annulment evaluations.

Pregnancy Services for women needing support and care during pregnancy.

Health Services include medical clinics in St. Cloud, Wildwood and Eustis that serve poor, uninsured individuals and families.
